SUMMARY NOTES & CASE CONTEXT

This compiled document set covers the initial search warrant execution (April 15, 2026) and subsequent arrest/charging/release process (May 2026) in Forsyth County case 26CR302000-330. KEY FACTS FROM DOCUMENTS: • Search Warrant executed at 417 Charles Conner Dr., Kernersville on 4/15/2026 at ~12:33 PM by Kernersville PD (Master Police Officer) / Winston-Salem PD reference. • Items seized: Pair of glasses, pillow, black box and contents (context indicates ~1 lb marijuana discovered in locked black box). • Probable cause based on reported assault on Jamie Parson (head injury, bruising, later seizures/intubation en route to hospital). Family concerns (brother John Parson, sister Krissy Koch) regarding relationship dynamics, prior unreported DV, possible object throwing, shared dog threat, frequent marijuana/alcohol use, and defendant's Adderall overuse on 4/13/2026. • Reference to 2020 domestic violence charge in Rockingham County involving ex-partner (broken door, struck in chest, grabbed by arms). • Arrest Warrant issued ~May 8, 2026 with four counts centered on marijuana-related felonies and paraphernalia (371.28g marijuana cited in PWISD count). • Release on May 11/12, 2026 via \$7,500 unsecured appearance bond (no cash/surety posted). Fingerprints required. Magistrate P. Rivera. • Defendant is U.S. citizen/legal resident per judicial finding. IMPORTANT CONTEXT (from public records and case history): The marijuana possession charge was resolved via G.S. 90-96 conditional discharge (substance abuse assessment completed, 30-hour class requirement). A review hearing was scheduled for November 2026. Consistent witness statements (victim Jamie Parson post-hospital and son Mason) supported a medical event/seizure explanation rather than intentional assault in some accounts. 4th Amendment warrant particularity issues were analyzed in related legal research.
